

Mother's Day Zoom Surprise Craft Supply List

Give this list to your kids to pull together BEFORE they Zoom with me! Have older siblings help their younger brothers and sisters to complete this activity. They can either create one project from all of them or get enough supplies to allow each child to make one! If you only have youngster(s), maybe Dad or Gramma can be in on the surprise!

1. an empty jar or can with labels washed off-1 for each project
-baby food or other small type jar or small soup can is best unless it is group project
2. some sort of paper such as wrapping paper, construction paper, copy paper
3. a container with enough "filler" to fill your jar or can half full
-filler examples: dirt, fish tank rocks, dried peas/beans etc., tiny rocks, marbles, beads
4. egg carton-cardboard or Styrofoam is best-1 is good for 3 projects/group
-can use tiny dixie cups or Keurig pods if you do not have egg carton
5. three 5-6" skinny things for 1 project or 2 each for group
-examples: coffee stirrers, skinny sticks, wooden BBQ skewers, old pencils
6. tape and/or glue sticks
7. permanent markers if using Styrofoam or want to color on plain tin can
8. markers, crayons, scissors
9. any decorations you might like such as glitter, sticker etc.
10. 1 piece of ribbon (best), yarn etc. for each project
-has to be long enough to tie a bow around the top of the jar/can
